

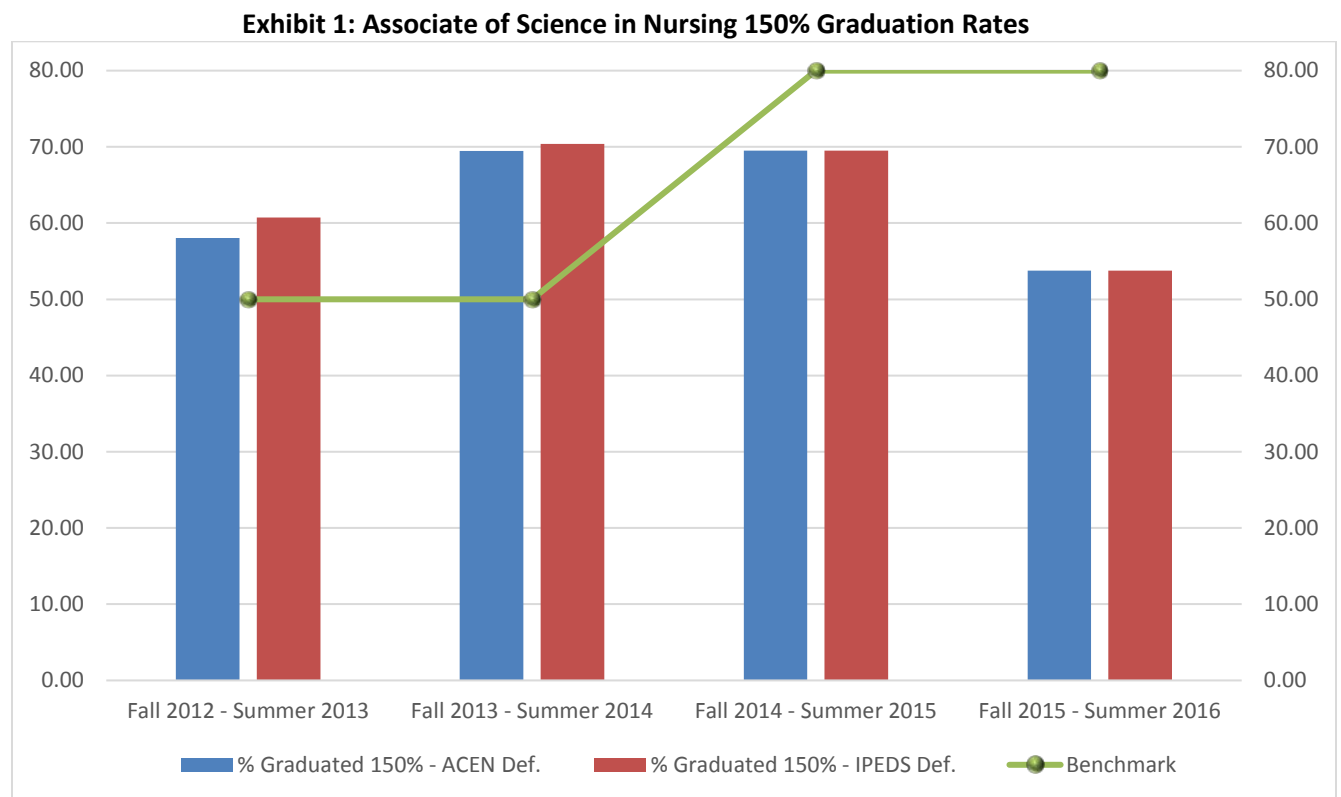


150% Graduation Rates for the Associate of Science in Nursing

The School of Nursing monitors 150% graduation rates for each cohort in the Associate of Science in Nursing (ASN). The original benchmark was to maintain a graduation rate of 50% and was set in fall 2012; however, the benchmark was adjusted in 2014 to 80%.

Exhibit 1 illustrates the Associate of Science in Nursing 150% graduation rates for each cohort. Graduation rates are defined as a cohort completing the program within 150% from the matriculation term.

The ACEN definition for 150% is calculated as a student graduating within six semesters within the matriculated term for the ASN cohort and four semesters for the LPN to RN cohorts. The IPEDS definition for 150% is calculated as graduating within three years (or 9 semesters) from the matriculation term.
