

Employment Rates for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing

The School of Nursing monitors employment rates for each cohort in the Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN). The School of Nursing has set its benchmark at fall 2014 and maintain the employment rate for either full-time or part-time employment at 100%. Note that the fall 2012 cohort for the Bachelor of Science in Nursing was the first cohort for the program. Additionally, all students admitted to the program are already employed full-time or part-time in the field.

Exhibit 1 illustrates the School of Nursing's employment rates for each cohort.
