

## Three-Year Graduation Rates for Associate's Degree-Seeking First-Time Full-Time Freshmen

The College monitors three-year graduation rates for associate's degree-seeking first-time full-time freshmen as a measure of success compared against the University System of Georgia's state college sector three-year associate's degree seeking first-time full-time freshmen graduation rates. The target is to meet or exceed the state college sector three-year institution-specific and system-wide graduation rates. A comparison with the state college sector demonstrates that SGSC performed above the sector rate in this category; therefore, the performance target was met.

Exhibit 1 illustrates SGSC's institution-specific graduation rates for the institution in comparison to the state college sector. Institution-specific graduation rates can be defined as a cohort beginning at home institution and graduating from home institution within three years.


