The Board of Regents [POLICY ON THE USE OF COPYRIGHTED WORKS IN EDUCATION AND RESEARCH](#) (BOR University System of Georgia) explains in detail the rights of copyright holders, which are balanced by limitations on those rights under federal copyright law.
