Cuban Black Beans and Rice

- 1 lb dried black beans (2 cups) sorted, rinsed
- 1 large onion, chopped (1 cup)
- 1 large bell pepper, chopped (1 1/2 cups)
- 5 cloves garlic, finely chopped
- 2 dried bay leaves
- 1 can (14.5 oz) can diced tomatoes, undrained
- 5 cups water
- 2 tablespoons olive or vegetable oil
- 4 teaspoons ground cumin
- 2 teaspoons finely chopped jalapeno chili
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 3 cups hot cooked rice



1. In 3-4 quart slow cooker, mix all ingredients except rice
2. Cover; cook on high heat setting 6-8 hrs
3. Remove bay leaves. Serve beans over rice.



If you use the new Gil-Find library catalog <http://gilfind.waycross.edu>, you can do the following six things:


- Search for books in the Waycross College library.
