MOVE ON WHEN READY

WHAT IS MOWR?

Move On When Ready (MOWR) provides you with the opportunity to earn high school AND college credit BEFORE graduating from high school. You can take classes on our Douglas or Waycross Campuses and even earn enough college credit to receive an associate's degree while graduating from high school at the same time! MOWR courses transfer to any institution in the University System of Georgia.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

If you attend an eligible public high school, private high school, or home study program and are entering the 10th, 11th, or 12th grade, you can apply for the MOWR program. You must have a minimum 3.0 academic high school GPA and eligible scores from the SAT, ACT, Compass, or Accuplacer tests.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Tuition for the MOWR program is covered by the Georgia Student Finance Commission (GSFC). MOWR does not cover course related fees. There are a limited number of courses which are not covered by the GSFC. This means you would be responsible for paying tuition for those courses the GSFC does not cover.

If you receive college credit for classes taken in high school, that credit WILL NOT count towards the HOPE Scholarship or HOPE Grant hours available to you after you graduate high school.

WHAT ABOUT BOOKS?

As a MOWR student, you will be provided books at no cost for each class in which you enroll. If you take classes on one of our campuses, books will be loaned to you from the SGSC bookstore. Should one of your courses not be covered by the GSFC, you would be responsible for purchasing the course textbook.

HOW CAN I APPLY?
