*Students are encouraged to complete as many required core classes as possible prior to starting the nursing program.				
*Students need to review and be familiar with the admission requirements for the nursing program.				
*Application for the nursing program opens annually on October 1st.				
*Students must achieve a minimum grade of "C" in all core courses applicable to the nursing program.				
*Students must have a minimum of 2.50 GPA to qualify for admission to the nursing program.				
*Students with no SAT/ACT scores OR scores below 920 (SAT) or 20 (ACT) must complete 21 semester hours for program consideration. Eight of those hours must include BIOL 2210K & BIOL 2211K.				
*Students must complete the SGSC version of the HESI A2 Admission Assessment Test including the Critical Thinking portion through Evolve at Prometric Testing sites or on site at SGSC (Douglas/Waycross) campus for admission consideration. Only two attempts per year are allowed. The minimum accepted score is 75 on all identified sections. Scores are valid for up to 2 years following testing.
