SGC Consortium Agreement Cover Letter for Students

Purpose of a Consortium Agreement

According to the Department of Education, a Consortium Agreement allows a student to receive student financial aid (SFA) funds while studying at a school other than his/her "home" institution. The home institution is the institution that will grant the students degree. The courses taken at the host institution must be applied towards the degree at the home school in order for the student to receive aid for those courses taken at the host school.

Steps for Receiving Financial Aid as a Consortium Student

1. Complete Consortium Agreement
2. Return the Following to the Office of Student Financial Aid along with transient permission from the Registrar.

NOTE: Your Pell Grant award in BANNER is calculated at full-time enrollment (12 hrs). Your Pell Grant will be prorated according to the hours of enrollment. **Students must pay any fees that they incur at the Host Institution by the fee payment deadline for the Host Institution. SGSC will not send your financial aid to your Host Institution to pay your tuition and fees.** Refund of SGSC financial aid will be disbursed to the student during the scheduled disbursement dates for each semester. If you withdraw from the class or the class has been cancelled after financial aid has been paid, you may owe money back to SGSC. At the end of the semester, you will need to make arrangements with the "host" institution to have your transcript(s) sent back to the SGSC Registrars Office. Aid for the following semester **will not be awarded** until this transcript is received. ***This process must be completed each semester you wish to take a class or classes at another institution in order to receive Financial Aid.***
