Please note that all graduation rates apply to first-time, full-time, undergraduate degree-seeking students and are based on up to 3 years of enrollment for associate degree programs, which equates to 150% of the normal completion time. Graduation rates do not include students who left school to serve in the armed forces, on official church missions with a foreign aid service of the federal government, or students who died or were totally disabled.
