Enrollment for Fall 2026 is Up

The SGSC online News states that, "In the first week of the semester, SGSC's total fall enrollment stands at 2,086 students, compared to 1,927 students at the same point last year, an increase of 8.25 percent." The News page goes on to state that new student enrollment numbers are looking great as well with a 18.64% growth, just this fall semester. As for the residence halls on Douglas campus, there has been an 51% increase in residential students. Along with the vibrant new faces we see on campus, we are seeing a ton of returners as well. Per the faculty and staff, the number of students facing academic probation or suspension has significantly decreased. This means more successful students all around, and we are happy to hear it!
