ENGL 1102 Composition II	3	- The student must be licensed in Georgia as a Registered Nurse (RN) with no current public or private disciplinary actions by the first day of enrollment in the RN to BSN program. - The student must maintain a current, valid and unrestricted Registered Nurse (RN) license throughout the nursing program. - For acceptance consideration into the RN to BSN Program, the student can only have 3 or less core classes remaining prior to beginning the program. The courses in BOLD are required if not already completed to fulfil core impact requirements. Students are required to complete one science sequence (See the science courses in BOLD). - Application for the nursing program opens annually on October 1st. - Students must have a minimum of 2.50 GPA to qualify for admission into the nursing program. - A grade of “C” or better is required for all general education core courses and Nursing courses to count towards degree completion. - Note: NURS * = USG RN to BSN shared collaborative course delivered through eMajor in 8-week sessions. - Completion of the eMajor Introduction Quiz is required before a student can be registered for their nursing courses. https://emajor.usg.edu/future-students/new-student-introduction-quiz/ - Apply for Summer graduation one semester prior to graduation.
